HOW DID ACTIOS START?

Looking back, ACTIOS has come a long way from the first meeting of interested churches on 15th September 2003. It was here that a steering group was set up to explore forming a charitable trust and subsequently employ a schools' worker for the St Neots area. In October of that year, the steering group met and the name ACTIOS (Assisting Christian Teaching In Our Schools) was decided upon. The group agreed that ACTIOS should become members of Scripture Union Associates Scheme – giving access to advice, experience and practical help to trustees and to any ACTIOS schools' worker.

Dot Lundy was a voluntary schools' worker for several years and the first paid schools' worker, Chris Downes, was employed in Jan 2007.

TO DATE:

From small beginnings, ACTIOS has become known and respected throughout the schools in and around St. Neots.

Two part time schools' workers are now employed and regularly visit 13 primary schools where they lead collective worship, take RE lessons and support the schools where needed. They also lead RE lessons in Longsands Academy on an occasional basis.

ACTIOS has taken Prayer Spaces and 'it's your move' into schools, been involved with Challenge Team UK, as well as Scripture Union's Lifepath event. Holiday clubs have been run in St Neots with the support of ACTIOS.

- Draw together and complement the existing activities, volunteers and other Christians in schools
- Pioneer and encourage new initiatives
- Train and equip volunteers and the Christian community in the St Neots area to serve our schools
